I would like invite you to support a unique collection of trees – the Oregon Grove of the States. Planted almost 50 years ago, this collection of the state tree from all 50 US states has fallen into disrepair. But you can help bring it back. You have the opportunity to not only improve our environment and be a part of a historic event, but also participate in something so unique that an opportunity like this won't likely come around again in our lifetimes.

What is the Grove of the States? Located at the southbound I-5 French Prairie Rest Area, (which is visited by over two million people per year) this public arboretum was conceived by former Attorney General Robert Thornton in 1967. His intent was to honor Lady Bird Johnson's Highway Beautification Act by planting a tree that represented every state in the US.

Why do we need your help? The Grove represents Oregon's commitment to a sustainable environment and is a direct connection to thousands of travelers who stop for a stroll underneath its leafy canopy. Over the years the condition of the Grove has been in serious decline, with tree losses due to disease and crowded conditions.

Oregon Travel Experience is now spearheading the restoration of the Grove in time for its 50th Anniversary Celebration in August 2017. We need your help to reach our goal of \$100,000 to plant replacement trees, restore and expand walking paths, and install new interpretive signs.
