

## PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET



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### SUBJECT: OAK GROVE REST AREA RESTROOM EXPANSION PROJECT

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**OVERVIEW:** This project will replace both the existing northbound and southbound restrooms built in 1970, with new larger capacity restroom buildings. This project also entails new concrete and pavement directly adjacent to the new restroom buildings. This project is part of a multi-phase capital improvement program to upgrade rest areas throughout Oregon.

**LOCATION:** This project is within the Oak Grove Northbound and Southbound Rest Areas located along I-5 at MP 206, 13 miles north of Eugene.

**PURPOSE AND NEED:** The project is needed to ensure the rest area meets the current and future demand of highway travelers along I-5.

**COST AND FUNDING:** The overall project costs are anticipated to be about \$2.2 million. Funding for this project was provided by HB 2017.

**TIMELINE:** The project is in construction with completion scheduled for early fall 2019. Construction activities are expected to take place during daylight hours Monday through Friday.
