Food businesses **MUST** meet **ALL** Qualifications

- ☐ Located in a permanent building (Coffee kiosks, food carts/trucks, food pods **DO NOT** qualify)
- ☐ Restroom facilities
- ☐ Primary business operation is the providing of meals. A meal is defined as a combination of food items that are prepared and cooked on the licensed premises that includes one principal item and one side dish.
- ☐ Indoor seating for at least 20 people or 10 drive-in stalls for car-hop service
- ☐ Health permit of food license with seating capacity details
- ☐ Under 21 years of age allowed on site
- ☐ Conforms with all applicable laws and ADA guidelines
