TOD Categories

TOD MUST fall within at least one category

- ☐ Amusement — activity or business for enjoyment, fun or relaxation
- ☐ Cultural — relates to agritourism, local agricultural products, artisan demonstrations, artistic pursuits, handicrafts, or local gift/souvenir shops
- ☐ Cultural District — cluster of similar businesses within six city blocks, with no less than four like businesses (Cultural Districts may include Antique, Brewery, Distillery, Historical and Winery Districts)
- ☐ Historical — reflects past events of the area
- ☐ Leisure — activities for exercise, exploration or recreation

3. Licenses or documentation for agritourism:
 - ☐ Brewery – copy of license to offer tasting and to sell malt beverages at retail directly to the consumer
 - ☐ Coffee Roasting/Tasting – copy of license to offer tasting and to sell locally roasted beans at retail directly to the consumer
 - ☐ Distillery – copy of license to offer tasting and to sell spirits at retail directly to the consumer
 - ☐ Tasting Room – copy of license to offer tasting and to sell wine, cider, and/or spirits at retail directly to the consumer
 - ☐ Tours/Trails – one qualifying business acting as a starting point and must provide a regular and reasonable tour/trail fully described in a brochure with a map
 - ☐ Vineyard – proof of onsite vineyard of at least 15 acres
 - ☐ Winery – copy of license to offer tasting and to sell wines or cider at retail directly to the consumer
4. Map or sketch of business location relative to highway intersection. The map is vital in determining eligibility. It should clearly show facility location, intersecting roads, landmarks, and distance from intersection to facility. Detail any obstructions that may affect motorist safety.
5. Map showing District cluster of like businesses in a concentrated area of no less than six city blocks in size and with no less than four like businesses
6. Photographs of signage at facility.
